Asian emerging economies account for two-thirds of global growth. The rise of Asian emerging economies raises the question of how these economies can combine sustainability with continued economic growth.

Understanding the impact of emerging Asia on the environment and climate change is the paramount contemporary challenge for both development-oriented researchers and policymakers.

This special issue aims to gather empirical, review, and theoretical research, which provides a significant contribution to the understanding of the connections between economics, society, and environment for sustainable development in Asian emerging economies.

We encourage the submission of research on the economic and business mechanism, governance and leadership, social responsibility, environment and climate change involving internal and external factors, different contexts and levels of Asian emerging countries.



We welcome both theoretical submissions that serve as a foundation for empirical work and theoretically based empirical work following the normal standards of JABES.

Contributions may focus on topic areas that include, but are not limited to:

- Best practices of managing the business and economic activities for sustainable development
- Role of governance and leadership, social responsibility in managing for sustainable development.
- Transforming productive resources and technological innovation into sustainable development.
- Eco-system and innovations for sustainable development.
- Challenges and opportunities for Asian emerging economies towards sustainable development.

### Submission procedure

The selected high-quality research paper submitted and accepted for presentation in **the Thirteenth Vietnam Economist Annual Meeting (VEAM 2020)** on June 25-26, 2020 in Binh Duong, Vietnam will be considered for publication in **the Journal of Asian Business and Economic Studies**. After the initial screening by the guest editors, the submissions will go through a rigorous double-blind review process. On the compilations of referee reports the editors will make final decision. The submissions which are found to be internationally excellent in terms of originality, significance and rigour will be considered for publication.
